Manuscript ID QJ-14-0247.R1 entitled "Sea Surface Temperature intraseasonal variability in the tropical Atlantic: air-sea interaction over upwellings fronts." .

Thank you for submitting your revised manuscript to the QJRMS. Whilst the majority of the referees comments have been satisfactorily addressed, the paper requires some improvement of the English before it can be considered suitable for publication. Having consulted the Associate Editor handling your paper, I suggest that you ask a native English speaking colleague to take a look at the paper to catch minor errors in grammar and syntax. Provided you do this, I would hope to accept the paper for publication.

Please submit your revised paper within 4 weeks of this request. Please also note that the free page limit is 16 pages for papers submitted before 10th October 2012, and 14 pages for original submissions after this date. Excess pages will be charged at £110/page. A charge of £250 for the first colour printed page and £150 per page thereafter will be levied to cover the additional printing costs involved.

You can upload your revised manuscript and submit it through your Author Centre. Log into <http://mc.manuscriptcentral.com/qj> and enter your Author Centre, where you will find your manuscript title listed under "Manuscripts with Decisions".

When submitting your revised manuscript, please indicate any revisions: you can do this by using the "track changes" feature in Microsoft Word, or, if you are using LaTeX, simply by changing the font colour to red to highlight what has been edited.

IMPORTANT: Please make sure you closely follow the instructions for acceptable files. When submitting (uploading) your revised manuscript, please delete the file(s) that you wish to replace and then upload the revised file(s).
